Checkout Instructions

- Checkout time is at 11 AM

Inside the Dome

- Wash dishes and place them back in their designated spot. If they are still wet, please leave in drying rack or on drying mat
- Turn off the AC/HVAC unit (instructions on separate page)
- Turn off and unplug all the counter top appliances (kettle, single burner, toaster, Keurig only)
- Remove all used bed linens (bed sheets and pillow covers only) and place in hamper
- Place all used towels in the hamper
- Ensure all waste is placed in the garbage or recycling bins in the kitchen area
- Turn off all the lights
- Lock door behind you when you leave

Outside the Dome

- Ensure the fire pit area and surrounding area is clean of garbage
- Extinguish fire
- Ensure the patio table is clean of garbage
- Turn off the propane tank for the BBQ

Please be respectful of the property and keep it clean.

Dome Rules

1. **No shoes within the dome.** To keep the floors clean, please place outdoor shoes on the shoe rack beside the front door.
2. **No smoking inside the dome.** Extra cleaning fee to remove odor and stains may be applied.
3. **Furniture** such as lounge chair, bed, side tables, outdoor patio set and muskoka chairs **should not be moved from their original location.** Damage to furniture will incur additional charges for replacement
4. The following linens are provided in each dome:

2 bath towels	1 bath mat	2 throw blankets	1 duvet comforter
2 hand towels	2 decorative pillows	4 pillows	2 bed sheets

Please note the top bed does not include a comforter. **Please place all used linens (towels, pillow cover and bed sheets only) in the hamper** before checking out.
5. Our domes are equipped with **AC/HVAC units** to keep guests comfortable in Ontario's hot summers and harsh winters! **Please ensure the unit is turned off before checking out.** Instructions are provided on the next page.
6. The following kitchen utensils and appliances are provided in each dome:

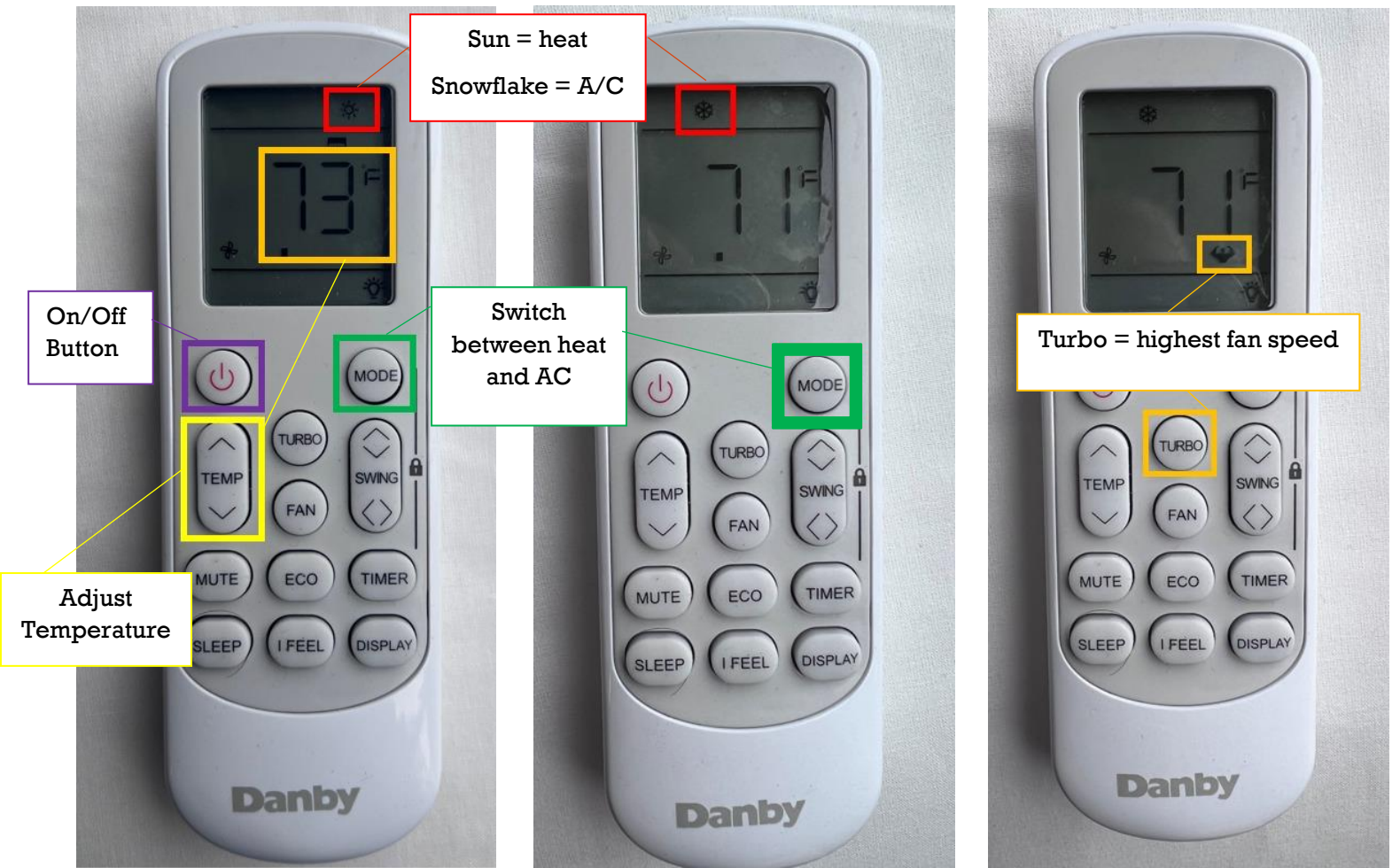

Please wash dishes and utensils and place them back in their designated spot after use. If dishes are not washed an extra cleaning fee may be applied.
Turn-off and unplug all counter top appliances (kettle, Keurig, single burner and toaster only) when they are not in use.
7. Fire Pit is located in front of each dome for guest use. Please note firewood is not provided. Do not leave the fire unattended. **Please extinguish fire** before returning to the dome and before checking out.
8. BBQ can be used leisurely by guests. BBQ cleaning supplies and cooking equipment are located in the utility cart inside the dome. Please cleanup after yourself and **keep the grill clean. Return all supplies back to the utility cart.** If BBQ is found dirty and requires extra cleaning, an extra cleaning fee will be applied. Propane tank is also provided. **Please ensure to turn off the propane tank** after each use and before checking out. If the propane tank is left on the cost to refill all used propane will be charged.
9. Although we would like for you to be as loud as you'd like, we must be mindful of our neighbors. Please note that each dome is 40 ft apart so it may be possible for you to hear the neighboring guests. The domes are not 100% soundproof so you may hear what is happening outside the dome. Taking this into consideration, **please keep noise to a minimum after 10PM.** We cannot guarantee a noise free experience during your stay.

Please be respectful of the property and keep it clean. Thank you for being a SUPER GUEST!



AC/HVAC Instruction Manual



Please remember to turn off the AC/HVAC when you are not inside the dome and before you check out



Keurig Instruction Manual



Step 1: Add water to the Keurig machine



Step 2: Insert K-cup pod into the machine and close the lid



Step 3: Place coffee mug on the tray

Step 4: Turn on the machine by clicking the power button

Step 5: Select 6 **or** 8 oz ONLY

Please remove the used K-cup pod and dispose of it in the garbage and clean the bottom tray if there is any spillage.

Don't forget to enjoy your coffee!



Guest Information

First Aid Kit: Stored in the far right kitchen cabinet. In case of emergencies, please call 911.

Fire extinguisher: Stored in the far right kitchen cabinet. In case of emergencies, please call 911 or South River Machar Fire Department: (705)-386-0066. Cooking is the number one cause of residential fires in Ontario. **Please do not leave your cooking unattended and avoid having loose clothing and articles near the burner. NEVER attempt to extinguish a grease fire with water.**

Shower: Guests are able to enjoy hot showers. However, it is important to note the **hot water runs for an average of 8 minutes**. If the hot water runs out, guests will need to wait 30 minutes to enjoy a hot shower. Please bring your own hair care products and bodywash as they are not provided.

Water: Out water is tested regularly and is safe for consumption. However, it is not chlorinated. Please bring your own drink water if you feel more comfortable, or, the tap water can be boiled in the kettle provided.

Wild animals: This area is home to a lot of Ontario Wildlife including deer, caribou, moose, black bears, coyotes, and gray wolves. Although sightings are rare, please keep this in mind and use your best judgement if seen. **DO NOT approach.**
